## Basic Supplies to bring to all FSDA meeting with a program

Basic Supply Kit Each Program is unique so there will be specific supplies needed in addition to the Basic Supply Kit. Not all basic supplies will be needed for each project but a good idea to have in your BASIC SUPPLY KIT. Palette knife, Palette (Wet, Waxed or Foam plate), Brush cleaner (Dawn dish soap or other), White eraser, Scissors, Pencil, Stylus, White & Dark Transfer paper, Tracing paper, masking tape either blue or green, Divided water container or 2 containers & Paper towels.

Americana Paints: Foliage Green, Plantation Pine, Lavendar Haze, Dioxazine Purple (purple tulips), Strawberry, Mauve-a-lous, (40th Anniversary Edition) for pink tulips , Titanium White and DecoArt Media – Payne's Grey (it is transparent). Neon's- Thermal Green

If you wish to do a different color tulip you will need a light color and a shading color.
