Basic Supplies to bring to all FSDA meeting with a program

Basic Supply Kit Each Program is unique so there will be specific supplies needed in addition to the Basic Supply Kit. Not all basic supplies will be needed for each project but a good idea to have in your BASIC SUPPLY KIT. Palette knife, Palette (Wet, Waxed or Foam plate), Brush cleaner (Dawn dish soap or other), White eraser, Scissors, Pencil, Stylus, White & Dark Transfer paper, Tracing paper, masking tape either blue or green, Divided water container or 2 containers & Paper towels. Wet Wipes and an assortment of brushes including a Stencil brush and Dry Brush (old scruffy)

It is IMPORTANT for members and guests pre-register so we will have an idea as to how many tables and chairs will be needed, plus the instructor may need to have an idea of how many will be painting especially if preparing paperwork and photographs.
